

On June 1, 2025 a Chiavetta's Chicken BBQ will be held in the parking lot of Lucky Lanes, 10387 Bennett Rd in Fredonia to benefit cancer patient Jace Haase and his family.

In November of 2024, Jace Haase, 11, of Frewsbug was diagnosed with T-cell lymphoma. The cancer was discovered when Jace was taken to the emergency room as he was suffering from back pain. During that visit, X-rays and a CT scan found a 10 centimeter by 10 centimeter mass in his chest. Jace was immediately transferred to a hospital in Plttsburgh, PA for more testing. Following a biopsy of the mass and a bone marrow biopsy, the doctor's confirmed that Jace has T-cell lymphoblastic lymphoma. Since then, Jace's father, Paul Haase, formerly of Dunkirk and now residing in Jamestown, has had to make the trip to Pittsburgh to be with Jace many times. Jace's treatments require him to be in Pittsburgh and close to the hospital for weeks at a time. Paul has had to take much time off from work as a result of his dedication to his youngest son. As the treatments in Plttsburgh continue, the medical bills are piling up, as well as travel expenses.
